



Hurricane Fence Opens New Regional Office to Expand Service Area

RICHMOND, VA - July 10, 2026 -

Hurricane Fence, a Class A licensed fencing contractor serving the Mid-Atlantic since 1994, has opened a fourth regional office, giving the company a standing local team dedicated to commercial fencing work across Northern Virginia, the District of Columbia, and Maryland. The office has operated since the start of 2026, extending the company's field presence beyond its Richmond, Portsmouth, and Raleigh/Dunn locations.

Until this year, Hurricane Fence's work in the Washington, D.C. metro area centered on high-security perimeter fencing for data centers and government facilities, staffed on a per-contract basis from the company's other offices. That model worked for large, planned projects, but it left general contractors and property managers without a local point of contact for smaller or faster-turnaround commercial work in the region. The new office gives the area a standing team reachable at (571) 369-3006 and broadens the company's work there to the same range of commercial fencing it performs company-wide, including perimeter fencing for warehouses and distribution centers, ornamental and chain link installations for retail and office properties, and gate and access control systems for secured sites. The office covers a roughly 50-mile radius that reaches into Maryland and the District of Columbia in addition to Northern Virginia.

Hurricane Fence's commercial work is backed by a Class A Contractor license (CIC FIC & HIC #2705024990), OSHA 30-hour safety training for field crews, and an in-house gate operator and access control division the company describes as the only one of its kind operated by a Virginia-based fence contractor. The gate team holds the IDEA Certified Automated Gate Systems Designer credential, an accreditation for automated gate system design professionals, along with Certified Automatic Gate Operator Installer and Certified Gate Attendant Designer designations. Those credentials and crews now serve the new office directly, rather than being dispatched from Richmond on a project-by-project basis, which the company expects will make its high-security and access control expertise available on a wider range of commercial jobs in the area, not only the largest data center and government contracts.

The company completed 3,143 projects across its service area in 2025 and has completed more than 20,000 projects from its Richmond location alone since 1994. Hurricane Fence holds an A+ rating from the Better Business Bureau, is an American Fence Association Blue Ribbon Company, and has earned the Highwire Gold Safety Award and ConstructSecure Gold Certification for jobsite safety performance. General contractors and property managers in the new service area now have a local point of contact for scheduling, estimates, and project coordination, rather than routing requests through the Richmond office. Site visits, material staging, and crew scheduling for the region now originate from the new office instead of a two-hour drive from Richmond, a change the company expects will shorten the turnaround between an initial estimate and a scheduled installation.

"Customers up there were calling Richmond for things a local team could turn around faster," said Dennis Sulser, owner of Hurricane Fence. "Having a team that lives in the market changes how quickly we can walk a site, put together a quote, and get started. That is the difference this office makes for the people we work with."
